MATCH DAY REGULATIONS (SUMMARY)

- 1. The number of players allowed entry to the pitch enclosure shall be a maximum of 30 for inter club games (Rule 6.26 T.O. 2017) for the following grades:
 - Senior, Intermediate, Junior and Junior "B" Championship.
 - In addition to this If a club is playing a double header with teams involved in a lower grade, passes will be issued for the lower grade also.
 - Passes will be issued for all adult finals.

Passes will be issued to clubs prior to the match by the County Secretary via email. Players will not be admitted to grounds without a valid pass.

- 2. Each Club will be issued with 8 Passes for mentors, to accompany their team and substitutes, to enter the playing area. No other club personnel are allowed on to the sideline or dugouts.
- **3.** Children are <u>not allowed</u> into the playing enclosure or dugouts. Note: Referees have been instructed not to commence a game if this is not being observed.
- **4.** The following are allowed **into the playing enclosure:** Team Manager, 3 Selectors, 2 Medical Personnel, Rúnaí and Cathaoirleach (**Total 8**).
- 5. The Team Manager and Maor Foirne are the only mentors allowed on the sideline to instruct the team and make switches and may move between the two 45M lines. *No selectors or club officials will be allowed on opposite side of pitch*.
- 6. Water/carriers (2) Football, (3) Hurling are to be positioned at the fence one on each side of the 45 Metre Line and may not enter the field of play. Water/carriers must not be under the age of 18 years.
- 7. Selectors are not permitted to be water carriers.
- **8. Distinctive Bibs** must be worn by Bainisteoir, Maor Foirne, Physio, Doctor and Water Carriers.

9. MAOR FOIRNE

The Maor Foirne (who must be a Selector) may enter the field of play during a break in play via the Substitution Zone and exit the field of play at the nearest endline or sideline after which he must return and remain seated in the designated area.

A Break in Play

A break in play is when the ball has gone out of play following a score or a wide or a stoppage in play called by the Referee for medical attention to an injured player. The taking of a free and/or sideline kick/puck does not constitute a break in play.

10. All Clubs please ensure your grounds are well presented for the forthcoming championship games i.e. Dressing Rooms, Referees Room clean and tidy and where possible a Scoreboard in operation.

Adequate parking should be provided for referee and his officials, especially where there are double headers.

- 11. For all finals in Páirc Tailteann the Captain will be the only member of the winning team allowed up to the Presentation area on the stand, except for Senior Finals the player receiving "Man of the Match Award" will also be allowed. This is to allow enough space for photos with our sponsors and for presentation of Cup. Rest of team will be allowed up for the Captains speech.
- 12. No mascots will be allowed.
- 13. All players must be uniformly attired i.e. proper club socks and togs.
- **14.** Players must line out as numbered in the programmes or on team lists provided to P.R.O. and Press on the day.
- **15.** Teams must be ready to start the game on time and all non-players must leave the field before the playing of the National Anthem.
- **16.** It is the function of the club Secretary and Chairperson to ensure all players and mentors are aware of the regulations, and to enforce them.
- 17. Fines will be imposed for breaches of the above Regulations by C.C.C.C.
